PEAN-Buiten is made up of twelve water lodges that were built in 2020/2021. PEAN-Buiten is spaciously laid out and each house is set in around 300m² of natural garden that is made up of farmlands and open water. Each house is unique and can fit a group of 4 to 16 people.

Sustainable and Regenerative Practices

- Packaging free groceries from Pieter Pot
- Natural soap from local entrepreneur
- Working with a company that aims to make coffee (and its production) future proof
- Use of The Good Roll, 100% recycled paper that is used to make toilet paper
- Fresh eggs from their own chicken coop
- Local and seasonal ingredients used for food and their cooking classes
- Mindfulness practices
- Renovated buildings instead of tearing them down and building new ones in its place
