



### **SKYR** SKYR

Undanrennan hituð að suðu. Síðan er hún kæld niður í hæfilegt hitastig fyrir skyrgerlana og skyrhleypinn sem er bætt í og undanrennan látin súrna í nokkrar klukkustundir. Þegar skyrið er hlaupið er það sett í léreftspoka og mysan látin leka af yfir nótt. Eftir að skyrið hefur verið kælt er það tilbúið til neyslu.

Skyr is a unique Icelandic milk curd, which is high in protein and almost fat-free. Skimmed milk is beated to boiling point, then cooled until it is lukewarm, and skyr starter culture (a little skyr from an older batch) is added, along with rennet. The mixture is left for several hours. When it has curdled it is transferred to mesh bags, and the whey is drained off overnight. The skyr is chilled, and is then ready to eat.




