

Irish CE4RT SME participant Muckross Creamery is a family farming business headed by John & Catherine Fleming.

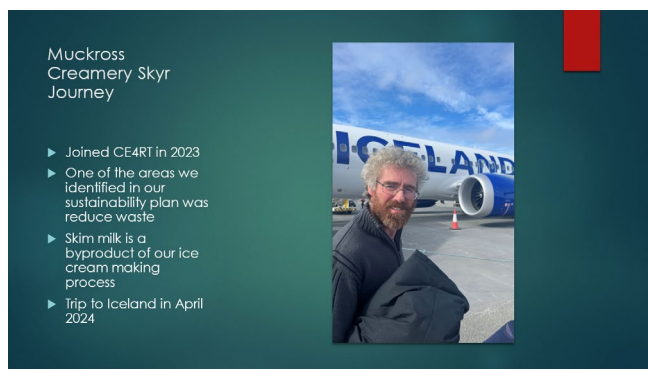
The business is located just outside Killarney in County Kerry, Ireland. Muckross Creamery are producers of an **award-winning Ice Cream** and when they joined the CE4RT programme in 2023 they identified **reduction of waste** as an issue for their business.



**Skim milk** is a by-product of their ice cream making business and for some time they had been investigating options for use of this (previously waste) product.



The **CE4RT Workshop on Wheels in Iceland in April 2024** presented a solution for them. John & Catherine travelled to Iceland and participated in the networking, seminars, reflections, presentations and visits to tourism businesses during the trip.

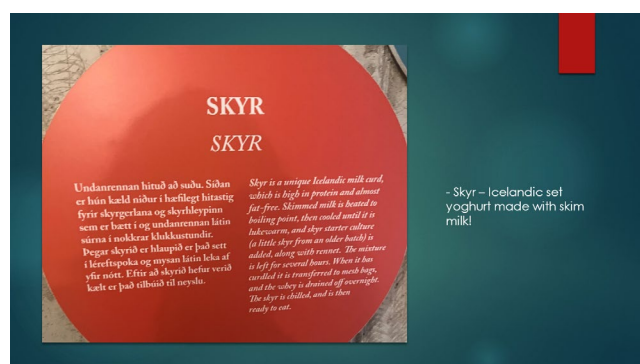
